Lakeside Regatta Information

General Information

The sail races of Lakeside Yacht Club are open to all members of I-LYA recognized clubs and U.S. Sailing members for the auxiliary fleet. The Lakeside Regatta is a counter for:

- CSA Boat of the Year Championship
- Tartan 10 Boat of the Year Competition
- CSA Women's Series

Fleets

PHRF and JAM classes are anticipated for the auxiliary fleet. Expected fleets for One-Design include: Tartan 10, Mumm 30, etc. Four boats will designate a fleet.

Rules

All races will be governed by the 2009 – 2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS); the prescriptions of the U.S. Sailing Association; the rules of participating classes; except as any of these are changed by this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions and any amendments thereafter.

Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be included in the Skipper's packet. Skipper's packets will be available at Lakeside Yacht Club on Friday July 10 at 5:00 PM through 9:00 AM on Saturday July 11.

Registration and Deadlines

All boats must register by completing the Lakeside Yacht Club 2009 Race Entry Form and sending it with the appropriate PHRF rating certificate and entry fee to the address designated on the form. Additional entry forms may be obtained at LYC. The registration deadline is 6:00 PM on Thursday July 9, 2009 for the Women's and the double handed Race. The deadline for the Saturday and Sunday races is 6:00 PM Friday July 10, 2009. There will be a \$10.00 fee for late registration.

Entry Fees

Entry fee for the LYC Women's Race is \$25 for U.S. Sailing members and \$30 for non-U.S. Sailing members. Entry fee for the LYC Doubled Handed Race is \$25 for U.S. Sailing members and \$30 for non-U.S. Sailing members. The entry fee for the Sat./Sun. races is \$75 for U.S. Sailing members and \$80 for non-U.S. Sailing members.

Skipper's Meeting

There will be a mandatory skipper's meeting at 6:00 PM on Friday for the LYC Women's Race, There will be a mandatory skipper's meeting at 6:00 PM on Friday for the LYC Doubled Handed race and at 8:30 AM on Saturday and Sunday for the remaining races. Scratch sheets will be provided prior to the races on Friday and Saturday.

Awards

There will be awards for each fleet as well as: The Ruhlman Trophy for Overall Regatta and the Depner Trophy for JAM

Dockage

For the LYC Regatta, "CSA Boat-of-the-Year" competitors will have free dockage from Wednesday July 8, 2009 through Tuesday July 14, 2009. Other boats will receive free dockage from Friday July 10th thru Tuesday July 14, 2009. Yachts requiring dockage must register at the LYC Gas Dock. (VHF Channel 9.)

Dockage for LYC Regattas

All boats requesting dockage must register at the LYC Gas Dock upon arrival. Call Lakeside Yacht Club on VHF Channel 9 or make arrangements with the LYC Harbormaster - Phone (216) 780-0153.

Dock assignments will be made on a "first-come, first-serve" basis. However, priority will be given to "CSA Boat-of-the-Year" competitors and boats that have entered all LYC events.

For the LYC Regatta, "CSA Boat-of-the-Year" competitors will have free dockage from Wednesday, July 8, 2009 through Tuesday, July 14, 2009. For the LYC Women's Race, all boats entered in the races will have free dockage from 12:00 PM the day before the event through 6:00 PM the day after the event.

After-race events for the regattas will take place on The Clubhouse Deck. Refreshments will be provided after the races for regatta participants and a special regatta menu will be available each day.
